



CPR & LVR - STANDARD

This course is relevant for Electricians who are needing to renew their CPR and LVR qualification on the same day.

The CPR component is trained prior to LVR and provides students with competent skills and knowledge to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies (CPR).

The LVR component provides electricians skills and knowledge on how to conduct risk assessments of an electrically hazardous situation and perform low voltage rescue procedures without hazard to themselves and others



Course Code and Title:

- HLTAID001 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- UETDRRF06B - Perform rescue from a live LV panel

Assessment: Written, practical and scenario-based assessment

Course Content:

The course will provide students with skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Recognise an emergency situation
- Identify, assess and minimise immediate hazards to health and safety of self and other
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for CPR
- Seek assistance from emergency response service
- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation in accordance with ARC guidelines
- Display respectful behaviour towards casualty
- Operate automated external defibrillator (AED) according to manufacturer's instructions
- Accurately convey incident details to emergency response services
- Report details of incident to workplace supervisor as appropriate
- Maintain confidentiality of records and information in line with statutory and/or organisational policies
- Prepare to perform rescue procedures from live LV panel
- Carry out rescue from live LV panel
- Complete the LV panel rescue procedure

Prerequisite: Students completing this course, must successfully complete HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) prior to proceeding to UETDRRF06B Perform rescue from a live LV panel.

Minimum Age Requirement: 14 Years

Certificate Valid: 12 Months from the date of course completion

Certificate Issued: Students who successfully complete all the training and assessment requirements will receive within 48 hours an electronic Statement of Attainment in HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation and UETDRRF06B – Perform rescue from a live LV panel.

Who Can Attend?

The course is relevant to Electricians who are needing to renew their currency CPR and LVR within the same day.

Factor to Consider:

Students attending course will be required to demonstrate their physical ability to perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an adult manikin placed on the floor to meet the performance criteria for assessment.
